Contractor submissions continue to be competitive and therefore there is a chance that bids will come in below budget. Works are scheduled to take place in Janaury/February 2013. Alternative parking solutions are currently being sought with network rail and Mars UK. The masterplanning element of the scheme was approved in principle at PFA 25th Sept 2012. Detailed heads of terms to be agreed with the Town Estate before advancing project. Town Estate have agreed in principle to contribute 50% of the total costs for this scheme.
