

Melton Village Facilities Audit 2011

This audit considers the range of local community facilities (primary school, post office, general store, general medical practice, pharmacy, community and leisure facilities, employment opportunities) and availability of public transport in Melton's villages.

The audit was completed in December 2011 following an assessment of the facilities and public transport. Comments on the accuracy of the audit have also been invited from parish council's.

NOTES:

Where a village has more than one example of a community and leisure facility (for example, two public houses, or a public house and community hall) it will meet 'community and leisure facilities' in the above list, effectively scoring 1 facility and service towards the threshold.

An assessment of quality is also made to determine whether the community has reasonable access to a service or facility i.e. a part time post office operating from a dwelling may not provide adequate access if the range of services and opening times are restricted.

The outcome of the audit is documented in the *village facilities table Dec 2011* and the responses received are documented in the *village facilities audit Dec 2011: consultation responses received* table.

MELTON LOCAL DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK CORE STRATEGY – VILLAGE SERVICES AND FACILITIES AUDIT

The Borough Council is in the process of preparing the Publication version of the Melton Core Strategy. You will recall that the amount of facilities and services that are present in a village is an important issue for the local development framework. You may also recall that we conducted an audit of the services and facilities available in settlements throughout the Borough last year.

The following eight functions were identified as being important in the provision of a sustainable community:-

- a) a primary school
- b) a post office
- c) a general store
- d) a general medical practice
- e) a pharmacy
- f) community and leisure facilities (e.g. village hall, public house, sports club)
- g) additional employment to that provided by a) to f)
- h) a regular, six day a week return bus service

We are in the process of reviewing and updating this information. We recognise that local knowledge is invaluable if we are to ensure the accuracy of the information.

I have enclosed with this letter the updated list of village services and facilities and I would be grateful if you could review the services and facilities listed for those villages within your parish and also identify any omissions or errors, if present.

May I take this opportunity to thank you for your assistance in this matter and I look forward to hearing from you in due course.
