This followed a period of detailed negotiation whereby a package of works, which will address all of the fire damaged parts of the building, will be removed, repaired and made good. The withdrawal of the appeal means that in the event of the works not being carried out, there are no remaining opportunities for appeal (enforcement would be via prosecution). The 'package of works' must be completed by 8 <sup>th</sup> Jan 2015.
