Comments

Scheme is fully committed and will continue to be monitored appropriately. The budget is expected to be fully used this financial year

These improvement works will be undertaken at the same time as some repairs and maintenance works are completed to save on costs, it is expected that these works will be undertaken within the next quarter.

Business case was submitted to programme board in July, the estimated costs have increased from £70k to £78k following quotes. The business case is now on this agenda.

Frontline vehicle has been purchased with the remaining budget expected to be fully used on EMT vehicle purchase.

Drainage works previously completed have improved the situation, continued monitoring is on-going. A business case will be submitted if it becomes necessary and in this case, the funds will be used.

In process of obtaining quotes for works, once received a Business Case will be compiled and submitted. It is intended that these works will be completed this financial year.

Planning application for phase 1 was submitted 27th July and good progress has been made on design and negotiations on a 20 year lease to the market partners. However, MBC is still awaiting formal written confirmation from the LLEP that the £3.5m grant funding is confirmed. Without this letter of confirmation it is considered too great a risk to proceed with any Capital Expenditure on this project, this has the potential to delay the project and steps are being taken to see if anything can be done to get the Grant letter released.
