PERFORMANCE STANDARDS FOR ELECTORAL REGISTRATION OFFICERS

1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 The purpose of this report is to make Members aware of a report received from the Electoral Commission regarding performance standards for Electoral Registration Officers.

- 3.3 There are 10 performance standards.
- 3.4 Melton Borough Council for 7 of the 10 standards is above the standard and for the remaining 3 is meeting the standard.
- 3.5 Further details of the standards is given in Appendix 1.
