# LICENSING ACT 2003 REVIEW OF STATEMENT OF LICENSING POLICY

### 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To inform members of this Council's responsibility to review its licensing policy and invite members to approve this reviewed policy. Appendix 1

### 1.2 **RECOMMENDATIONS**

2.1 That this Committee recommends that Full Council adopt this Policy.

#### 3.0 **KEY ISSUES**

- 3.1 The Licensing Act 2003 requires the Council to review its Licensing Policy every three years. Licensing Act 2003 S.5 (1) (a)
- 3.2 All Licensing Authorities are required to produce and publish a reviewed Statement of Licensing Policy to take effect no later than 11 January 2011.
- 3.3 If approved this Policy will go forward to Full Council for adoption on 16 December 2010.
- 3.4 The proposed changes to this Policy are in italics, these are minor changes with the exception of the adoption of a Cumulative Impact Policy.
- 3.5 The Cumulative Impact Policy has been introduced at the request of Leicestershire Constabulary. The evidence provided to prove the need for this is attached as Appendices 1 & 2 of the revised policy.

### 4.0 POLICY AND CORPORATE IMPLICATIONS

4.1 This Policy will determine the principles that the Council intend to apply in exercising their functions as the Licensing Authority under the act.
