Options	 Continue with existing lights that will require replacement over the next 5 years (over a phased period) at full market rate, with no revenue savings. The purchase of these units would secure Melton Town Centre's Christmas Lighting Scheme in its entirety for the next 5 years as all other units have been replaced and refurbished. These final units are the high cost main cross street displays with the centre and would usually cost in excess of £20,000 to replace. The current units cannot be used after the 2010/11 period due to health and safety reasons.
