L12	Apologies for Absence Apologies of absence were given by Councillor J. Hurrell and Councillor P. Baguley.
L13	Declarations of Interest  Councillor P. Faulkner declared a financial interest in agenda item 4 and 5.  Councillor P. Faulkner left the room.
L14	Minutes  Members highlighted the paragraph of the previous minutes about the age limit and that there was a consensus about this at the last meeting and clarification of unaccompanied children because of height. The Principal Solicitor reassured Members that the policies would be being looked at in the near future and asked if they were happy for it to be taken as an officer action.  Councillor J. Wyatt proposed, Councillor A. Freer-Jones Seconded, the vote was unanimous except Councillor J. Simpson whom did not vote as had not attended the previous meeting.  The minutes of the meeting held on 10th September 2018 were confirmed and authorised to be signed by the chair.
L15	Hackney carriage tariff increase  Members asked the Licensing and Compliance Officer about the existing Tariff and the percentages and asked if these can be provided before a decision made. A member queried the report in which it mentioned LE13 postcode defining the town and that this was in fact incorrect.  The Licensing and Compliance Officer mentioned that the LE13 was referenced in the letter received by the Trade and did not want to restrict it to the town.
