The event runs until 4am or 5am on a number of days and could cause considerable noise and light pollution disturbing people, livestock and wildlife. There may also be added traffic causing disturbance and nuisance given the gate closure times of 10pm or 11pm on the Friday, Saturday and Sunday per the FAQ on the Noisily website. No indication given on application of crowd and staff numbers or precise site.
