Public safety	Yes	The site is miles away from emergency support services. This does not seem to be a suitable location for a 4 day festival of up to 10000 people.
To prevent public nuisance	Yes	The site is in woods and fields next to Stathern, which is our village – I can see the woods from our house, and we're on the far side of the village from the proposed site. Tickets have already been sold for 6000 attendees, and remain on sale. This is a huge event, all these people in this location for 4 days, 24 hours a day, with the festival going on till 5am and starting again at 10am. The site doesn't have a natural amphitheatre, indeed it's on the side of the escarpment so all noise and light from the three stages will travel considerable distances across the Vale of Belvoir. The noise alone will have a huge detrimental impact on the people of Stathern, but the website and facebook page for th festival make it clear that lights and lasers are a key part of the shows. Our woods will be loud and glowing – and I don't think that is a positive. Public transport to this location is virtually non-existent (and even if there was a bus service it wouldn't make much of a dent in transporting up to 10000 people). So there will be thousands of private vehicles travelling along the local lanes, many of then through our village – which is already a bottleneck that gets clogged up.
