Offences under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981</li> <li>2. Increase in general crime in a low-crime area</li> <li>3. Illegal drug taking</li> </ol> <p>As yet I have not seen any information about the site and any plans in place to manage these issues. I note however that the timescale to the event happening is less than 6 months and this may not be sufficient to plan properly for an event of this nature.</p> |
| <b>Public safety</b>                 | Yes                      | <p>Again I have no details on the plans for the event. If however it is a large event, there are likely to be issues around the safety on the roads, particularly after the event when people who may have consumed alcohol etc may be travelling home by car.</p> <p>I would need to see proper event plans to be able to comment further.</p>   |
| <b>To prevent public nuisance</b>    | Yes                      | <p>This is a quiet rural area, and the roads around the venue are not able to cope with large amounts of traffic. Without understanding more about the event planning it is not possible to say there are no public nuisance issues.</p>  |
| <b>To protect children from harm</b> | Yes                      | <p>Again, I have not had access to any detail which would allow me to say there are no issues around harm to children.</p>  |

It may be seen from the above that I consider that all of the four licensing objectives may be relevant in the case of this application. I refer you to my representation for the Noisily Festival application for the type of specific issues which may be of concern. However, at present I have not got any details of the event, and even the exact location of the proposed site, and the expected number of attendees is not clear. If Barkestone Plungar and Redmile Parish Council receives further information about the event it may decide to withdraw the representation, and if not, to attend the Committee Hearing to provide further comments and suggestions regrading conditions etc.
