7. Decision Taken:

1. To enter into a 3-year contractual agreement with Baymedia to test, print, install, maintain and remove 10 x Lamp Post Banner on Scalford Road and Sherrard Street.

8. Reasons for Decision:

This decision is to award contract, which will be funded through money allocated to tourism and the visitor economy initiatives through the UKSPF, intervention (put the intervention number here E8.1 – funding for the development and promotion of wider campaign which encourage people to visit.

The objective of lamppost banner campaign is to raise awareness about campaigns, events and activities by local stakeholders with the key benefit of increasing footfall to the high street by signposting visitors at two key entry points to the town, into it to create additional trips into the town (from Scalford Road and Sherrard Street entry points).

Raised Lamppost Banners provide effective and efficient communication and promotion format using targeted community engagement campaigns, providing a high impact campaign to promote to tourists and residents alike.

Raised level advertisements 3m from the ground have a 2.5 times better memory recall rate than the same advert at ground level.

Suitable site locations (lamp posts) have been identified but are subject to structural testing prior to submitting for a highways licence application.

This project was agreed in consultation with key stakeholders and as part of the successful submission of the UKSPF investment plan which was approved by Cabinet on the 08 March 2023 (CA81).

The supplier has been procured in compliance with Melton Borough Council procurement policy, and all necessary due diligence has been carried out by the Council Officer.

The company in question have experience of delivering this activity in the Leicestershire area.

9. Authority / Legal Power:

Cabinet of 08 March 2023 delegated authority to the Director for Growth and Regeneration, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Growth and Prosperity, to authorise spend and undertake decisions, approvals and awards of contract that ensure continued delivery of the UKSPF programme in line with the investment plan. This is to include, not only council led projects, but also where funding needs to be released for delivery by a third party (via grants, commissioning, procurement of services etc).
