7. Decision Taken:

1. To amend the 2024/25 General Fund capital programme relating to grant funded leisure improvement works

8. Reasons for Decision:

The Council has been recently successful in securing £120k in grant funding from Sport England through the Swimming Pool Support Fund (SPSF) for solar panels and pool covers at Waterfield Leisure Centre to improve energy efficiency. This has been received after the capital programme was approved by Council at its February budget meeting so needs to be added to the capital programme as a result.

Alongside this, funding has been secured from the LLEP towards leisure improvement works totalling £2m which was initially split out between 2 schemes – leisure improvement £1.735m and energy efficiency works £0.265m. As a result of securing the SPSF grant it has been agreed in conjunction with the LLEP to reallocate the budget for the energy efficiency works into the leisure improvement scheme to provide increased opportunity to invest in the council's leisure facilities. Again, this will require the capital programme to be updated to reflect this.

In accordance with the delegations in place, the Director for Corporate Services is able to amend the capital programme where schemes are grant funded.

9. Authority / Legal Power:

The Director for Corporate Servies has delegated powers within chapter 2, Part 4 of the constitution, section 12.3 paragraph 54 permits: To approve, in consultation with the relevant Portfolio Holder, supplementary capital or revenue estimates where those estimates are fully funded through awarded ring-fenced grants.
