# **CAPITAL PROGRAMME MONITORING TO 31 JANUARY 2018**

#### 1.0 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 To update the Committee on the progress of schemes within the Capital Programme to 31 January 2018.

#### 2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 The progress made on each capital scheme, attached as Appendix A, be noted along with the year end forecast position.

#### 3.0 KEY ISSUES

3.1 Under the Capital Programme Project Appraisal System, monitoring of actual capital expenditure against authorised expenditure is undertaken on a regular basis and reported to the Senior Management Team. Appendix A gives details of the spending against budget for all schemes within this Committee up to 31st January which is the latest available information at the agenda date.

5.3 The main reason for the underspend is in relation to the Lake Terrace Waste Depot Refurbishment works for which a business case has not yet been completed. A recent survey of the site has shown that there are significant works required. The majority of these will fall to the existing operator and negotiations are required to agree on the works to be undertaken. These negotiations are not expected to be finalised until 2018/19 and a business case will be put forward at that time accordingly. The project will therefore be carried forward into 2018/19.

The remaining variance is in relation to the Partnership Scheme in Conservation project. The previous ambition to transfer the funds to Historic England's Heritage Action Zone (HAZ) programme has not come to fruition. However there is an ambition to address the condition of one property on Market Square in respect of which the funds may be required for incentivisation or match funding. In this scenario, authorisation will be sought to

transfer the sum. However, it is now not expected that this will be until 2018/19 and therefore the budget will be carried forward accordingly.
