Environmental Health recommends that the following conditions are attached to the licence.

- 1. All amplified equipment within the marquee/pavilion shall be regulated by a sound limiter at all times. The sound limiter must be installed above the dance floor within the envelope of the marquee/pavilion. The sound limiter shall be configured and set to a level first agreed with Melton Borough Council and permanently maintained within the established operational limits thereafter.
- 2. During daytime hours, 10:00 to 23:00, the marquee/pavilion sound limiter shall be set to a level of 90dB(A). Noise as measured 'on the dance floor' must not exceed a 15 minute equivalent continuous average of 90dB(A) at this time.
- 3. During night time hours, 23:00 to 00:00, the marquee/pavilion sound limiter shall be set to a level of 85dB(A). Noise as measured 'on the dance floor' must not exceed a 15 minute equivalent continuous average of 85dB(A) at this time.
- 4. Between the hours of 10:00 to 01:00 noise from regulated entertainment, measured as an LAeq 1 hour, must not exceed the background noise level at the facing façade of any residential receptor. The background noise level shall be measured as an LA90, 1 hour.
- 5. No amplified sound, music or speech shall be permitted in the external licensable areas between the hours of 23:00 07:00 or 00:00 07:00 in the case of the marquee/pavilion.
- 6. The main entrance doors to the marquee/pavilion shall be kept closed at all times bar access and egress. Between the hours of 23:00 and 00:00, the main entrance

doors shall be permanently supervised.

- 7. Except for the main entrance doors, all other points of access to the marquee/pavilion shall be kept permanently closed except in an emergency.
- 8. Clear and prominent notices shall be displayed at all exits and the car park requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and leave the premises and the area quietly.
