Representations re Scalford Hall Licensing Application.

Over the last 2 years there have been many instances of disorder, members of the public that attend various functions are allowed to roam freely around the grounds including areas that are not owned by Scalford Hall. They cause criminal damage, are abusive, and extremely loud whilst at the Hall and when departing.

They have no concept at all that their behaviour is unacceptable and it always remains unchecked and unsupervised by members of staff from the Hall.

There are only very small signs asking revellers to please respect neighbours. It requires a greater presence and signage.

I have lived at the hall for 30 years and have hardly ever had to go and complain about behaviour or disturbance. Now as a general rule I have to go and complain at least three times at most events that are held in the tent. The usual excuse is that the DJ is not running his equipment through the sound limiter this was a condition of use the sound levels were set by MBC environmental health team. They are just ignored. Management are nearly always unavailable.

This Public nuisance can start on Friday and continue through too Sunday evening. With drunken people staggering around the grounds shouting swearing, arguing being sick, all totally unsupervised or restricted due to the fact that the boundary fences belonging to the hall and private property are now non existent broken or in a very bad state. Apparently they do not have the money to repair.

also have concerns during the summer months for the Scout camp, the people attending functions seem to invariably use sat nav to arrive and depart and this takes them via the Holwell Road route past the scout camp where they seem to carry on their partying very loudly, very late at

night and early hours of the morning which I know has disturbed the camp and caused problems on many occasions.

It is a total nightmare now living here due to the management of the hall having no control. I believe that they should be made to adhere to general licensing guidelines as defined as all other licenses have too. Because we are fairly isolated they seem to think they can do as they like. I have complained continually but the same problems occur every time at the majority of their events.

I have complained to my local police and to the council. Both of whom we keep being told now have limited resources. I hope the licensing committee will take our concerns seriously and assist.
