LSC18	<p>Election of a Chair Councillor P. Baguley proposed Councillor J. Wyatt. Councillor P. Cumbers seconded. Councillor J. Wyatt was elected Chair.</p>

LSC21	<p>Taxi Driver Licence - failure to attend mandatory child sexual exploitation awareness training courses Exclusion of the Press and Public</p> <p>It was recommended that the Press and Public be excluded from the meeting during consideration of the item, as it involved the likely disclosure of exempt information relating to an individual as defined in Paragraph 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 (amended). A vote was taken, proposed by Councillor J. Wyatt and seconded by Councillor P. Cumbers. It was a unanimous decision.</p> <p>It was RESOLVED that the press and public be excluded from the meeting during consideration of the item, as they involved the likely disclosure of exempt information relating to an individual (including the Authority holding the information) as defined in Paragraph 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 (amended).</p> <p>The Licensee had been invited however did not attend the meeting. The Sub-Committee was adjourned until 1.10pm.</p> <p>The Assistant Director for Strategic Planning and Regulatory Services submitted a report of which copies of which had previously been circulated to members and Licensee.</p> <p>The Licensing and Compliance Officer summarised this report verbally which requested the Licensing Sub-Committee to consider the Licensee's suitability to retain a Hackney Vehicle and Private Hire Drivers Licence after failing to attend mandatory Child Sexual Exploitation Awareness Training.</p> <p>Members were given the opportunity to ask questions of the officer.</p> <p>It was resolved that the Licensee was deemed not a 'fit and proper person' and their Combined Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence should be revoked with immediate effect in the interests of public safety. The Legal Adviser</p>

advised that the Licensee had a right to appeal and a written decision would be issued within 5 working days of the hearing.
