a) General - all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 11)

- The park is on private land with restricted access
- We have risk assessments for each area and attraction within the theme park.
- The theme park has comprehensive public liability insurance to the sum of £5million.
- CCTV throughout the theme park including but not limited to; park entrance, retail outlets, F&B outlets, attractions (indoor and outdoor) and is kept in full working order and stored for 28 days, footage is accessible to the police, licensing department and any other authorised body immediately upon request.
- Personal license holder on the premises for staff training and licensing issues

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- The theme park has restricted access, we are a family theme park predominately and such attract families, restricting access to family demographics unless specifically for events (Halloween)
- We source outside, reputable security personnel and doormen for Halloween
- Bottle bans, search policies and age restrictions.
- CCTV throughout the theme park including but not limited to; park entrance, retail outlets, F&B outlets, attractions (indoor and outdoor) and is kept in full working order and stored for 28 days, footage is accessible to the police, licensing department and any other authorised body immediately upon request.
- Terms of entry stipulate CCTV recordings, signage around theme park stating CCTV recording.
- The sale of alcohol, beverages and food is stopped 30mins before park closing.
- We operate a strict challenge 25 policy with literature (posters) where sale of alcohol takes place – record kept of rejected sales (due to under age).

c) Public safety

- Risk assessments carried out in attraction and event at the theme park.
- Dedicated H&S administrator.
- Comprehensive public liability insurance.
- External companies we use for cinema screenings, staging, sound, fireworks and events are all vetted accordingly and carry their own insurances.
- Provision of lighting (standard and emergency), escape routes and evacuation points, first aid and first aiders available during open hours
- Advanced ticketing software and admissions to monitor number of attendees
- Abuse will not be tolerated signage around the theme park with information stating ejection from the park will result of physical and verbal abuse to staff and customers

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- Sounds kept to a respectable and reasonable level any queries from surrounding area / neighbours are acted on immediately. Provision of sound monitoring device and records kept. noise patrols of premises boundary
- The park reserves the right (with comprehensive terms and conditions of entry) to remove / refuse entry to any individual at its own discretion.
- Lighting is respectable to reduce light pollution
- Litter bins around premises including car park to reduce littering, litter pickers are sent out to remove litter from boundaries of theme park

e) The protection of children from harm

- We have a child safeguarding policy in place.
- We are a parental / guardian supervised park at all times. Children are required to have a parent / guardian with them and supervising at all times in all areas of the theme park.
- We do not offer crèche or staff supervised conveniences.
- CRB checks for Santa characters during Christmas season
- Outdoor cinema play age appropriate films, we do not exceed PG / U British Board of Film Classification and film choice is marketed ahead of screening for parent / guardian to determine suitability for children.

This application cannot be used to vary the licence so as to extend the period for which the licence has effect or to vary substantially the premises to which it relates. Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.

Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts – are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.

Live music: no licence permission is required for:

o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.

o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.

o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.

o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.

a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the peaks or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital

school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:

o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.

o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.

o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

 Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.

 Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:

o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority:

o any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;

o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and

o any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
