

Conditions in agreement with Leicestershire Police

Prevention of Crime and Disorder

1. The owner / staff will refuse to serve anyone who is intoxicated or causing disorder.
2. CCTV will be installed and the footage will be retained for a period of no less than 28 days.
3. CCTV footage will be made available to the relevant authorities within 24 hours of a request being made and all members of staff will be trained in the use of the CCTV system.

Public Safety

1. All staff will be given training in regards to the 4 licensing objectives.
2. All staff training will be refreshed every 12 months and recorded in the training book. This book will be kept on the premises and made available upon request from any relevant authority.
3. The licence holder will ensure that a refusal and incident log is maintained and updated accordingly. These records are to remain on the premises and made available immediately to the relevant authorities upon request.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

1. Prominent, clear notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting customers and staff respect the needs of local residents by keeping noise to a minimum when outside the premises and when leaving the premises.
2. The licence holder will ensure that trade deliveries and rubbish collections are only accepted during normal working hours.

Protection of children From Harm

1. Children under the age of 16 will not be allowed on the premises beyond 21:00 hours unless they are accompanied by an adult over the age of 21.

Additional Conditions.

1. To keep an up to date register of all staff employed including passport details, nationality, dates of birth & National Insurance numbers and made available to the relevant authorities immediately on request.
2. Mr Xia Ming Wong will not have any involvement with the premises at all.
