1 Summary

1.1 To inform the Committee of the Local Government Association's (LGA) consultation on the model member Code of Conduct.

2 Recommendation(s)

That Audit and Standards Committee:

- 2.1 note the current consultation in regards to the LGA's model Code of Conduct and provide any comments to the Monitoring Officer to feed into a response to the consultation.
- 2.2 recommend that the outcome of the consultation and the final version of the model member Code of Conduct be submitted to a future meeting of the Committee.

3 Reason for Recommendations

- 3.1 The Committee to consider whether it has any comments to make on the consultation.
- 3.2 The Committee to be presented with the final version of the model member Code of Conduct when it is published (expected in the autumn) and at that time consider whether any changes are required to the Council's member Code of Conduct.

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4 Background

4.1 The Local Government Association is providing a model member Code of Conduct as part of its work on supporting the sector to continue to aspire to high standards of leadership and performance.

5 Main Considerations

- 5.1 The LGA has committed to reviewing the current model member Code of Conduct, as recommended by the Committee on Standards in Public Life's report into Local Government Ethical Standards.
- 5.2 The LGA held an event on Civility in Public Life with a range of stakeholders at the end of 2019 and three consultation workshops at the beginning of 2020. The LGA consultation draft model member Code of Conduct is a result of this initial work.
- 5.3 The LGA has published the model member Code of Conduct for consultation. This is available to view on the LGA's website https://www.local.gov.uk/localgovernment-association-model-member-code-conduct.
- 5.4 The consultation will run for 10 weeks from Monday 8 June 2020 until Monday 17 August 2020.
- A comparison between the Council's member Code of Conduct and the consultation model member Code of Conduct has been made and this is attached to the report at Appendix B.

6 Options Considered

6.1 There are no alternative options at this time as the Committee is being informed of the consultation.

7.1 The Monitoring Officers across Leicestershire and Rutland are collaborating on the views provided to the LGA.
